3.1	<ul> <li>Under NO circumstances is ANYONE who has been overseas in the previous 14 days or been in contact with a person who is known to be COVID-19 positive, permitted to attend the Circuit.</li> <li>All Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons MUST:</li> <li>Complete and submit the Karting Australia COVID-19 Declaration at least 24 hours before the commencement time of the Event; and</li> <li>Forward to the Club's COVIDSafe Officer, the confirmation email that you receive after submitting the completed COVID-19 Declaration.         <ul> <li>If the confirmation email is not sent to the Club on time, you may not be granted access to the Circuit.</li> <li>If you have been overseas in the 14 days before the Activity or if you have been in contact with a Covid-19 Positive person, you will not be granted access to the Circuit.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
4.	HYGIENE FACILITIES - TOILET/WASHROOM FACILITIES and HAND SANITISER
4.1	The Club is required to provide facilities to ensure general and sensible hygiene practices are maintained.
4.2	Toilet and washroom facilities at the Circuit must be open and available for use.
4.3	<ul> <li>Washroom facilities must be properly equipped with liquid soap, running water and either air hand driers or paper towels.</li> <li>The toilets and washroom facilities must be cleaned at least once during the day or as otherwise required in accordance with the Club's COVIDSafe Action Plan</li> </ul>
4.4	It is strongly recommended that Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons bring their own supply of hand sanitiser for use in accordance with government recommendations in addition to hand sanitiser that is supplied by the Club.
